1 **SECTION 3. TRAIN RIDES.**

2 **Zoo Train Ticket**

3 **\$2 for adults**

4 **\$1 for seniors or children**

5 **Children under the age of 3 are free.**

6 **Member Train Pass**

7 **\$2 for adults**

8 **\$2 for seniors or children**

9 **Children under the age of 3 are free.**

10 **The member train pass shall be good for unlimited train rides and**
11 **requires NMBPS membership.**

12 **SECTION 4. MILITARY DISCOUNTS AND SPECIAL RATES**

13 **Military Discount**

14 **All active and non-active military receive a \$2 discount on adult**
15 **tickets and a \$1 discount on children's tickets. Individuals must**
16 **present a military ID. The discount shall be good for general**
17 **admission only.**

18 **Special Rates**

19 **The Cultural Services Department may provide discounts or special**
20 **rates for certain periods of time or to groups including, but not**
21 **limited to, school groups, recreation groups, children, and New**
22 **Mexico BioPark Society members. In addition, the Cultural Services**
23 **Department may provide for reduced admission to members of other**
24 **institutions which have reciprocal agreements with the BioPark.**

25 **SECTION 5. SUBSEQUENT REVIEW. The Administration will collect the**
26 **appropriate data to conduct an analysis within 18 months regarding whether**
27 **fees for the BioPark visitors who reside outside the Albuquerque City limits**
28 **should be increased and provide a recommendation to the City Council upon**
29 **analysis of the data collected.**

30 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, sentence,**
31 **clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be**
32 **unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction,**
33 **such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the**

1 Ordinance. The Council, the Governing Body of the City of Albuquerque,
2 hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
3 subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any one
4 or more sections, sentences, clauses, words or phrases being declared
5 unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

6 SECTION 7. COMPILATION. Sections 1 through 4 of this Ordinance shall
7 be incorporated in and made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque,
8 New Mexico, 1994.

9 SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect five days
10 after publication by title and general summary.
