F/S O-15-2 SPONSORED BY: **Trudy Jones** 1 **ORDINANCE** 2 AMENDING THE BALLOON FIESTA PARK COMMISSION ORDINANCE. 3 CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 10 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES 4 ALBUQUERQUE. 5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 6 ALBUQUERQUE: 7 SECTION 1. Sections 10-10-4 and 10-10-5 of the Balloon Fiesta Park 8 Commission Ordinance are amended as follows: 9 "§ 10-10-4 COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION. 10 The Commission consists of 11 voting members and 3 nonvoting, exofficio members. The Commission shall not include any elected city officials. 11 - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 Voting members may serve up to three consecutive, three-year terms subject 13 to reappointment as provided through the process for appointment described Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] 14 in subparagraphs 'A' and 'B' below. However, the Pueblo of Sandia member 15 created by subparagraph (A)(5) is not subject to any term limits. Terms of 16 voting members are staggered as to the year of completion. Members are not 17 required to be residents of the City of Albuquerque. 18 (A) The following are voting members subject to appointment by the City 19 Council upon recommendation of the respective entity that the member is 20 representing: 21 Two representatives from the Board of Directors of the 22 Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta: 23 One representative from the Wildflower Neighborhood 24 **Association:** 

One representative from the Alameda North Valley Association:

- 1 One person representing the broader recreation interests of the 2 community and the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Advisory Board; 3 One person representing the Pueblo of Sandia; 4 Two at-large positions to be filled by persons residing in other 5 areas of the city, in particular, one person from the west side of the City and 6 the other person from the east side of the City. Notwithstanding the language 7 of subparagraph (A) above, these at large positions do not require a 8 recommendation by any particular entity prior to being filled by the Council; 9 and 10 **(7)** One representative recommended by the Albuquerque AMA Club 11 Chapter. 12 (B) The following are voting members appointed by the Mayor with the 13 advice and consent of the City Council: 14 One person representing local businesses located near the park: 15 (2) One person representing the Albuquerque Convention and 16 Visitors Bureau. 17 The following are non-voting, ex-officio members: 18 The Director of the Parks and Recreation Department, or designee; 19 and 20 (2) A City employee designated by the Mayor to represent public 21 safety issues: 22 (3) A city employee designated by the Mayor to represent the 23 Anderson-Abruzzo Albuquerque International Balloon Museum. 24 § 10-10-5 DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE COMMISSION. 25 The Commission is hereby created to advise and make recommendations 26 on the operation, management, and development of the park with the following 27 duties and powers: (A) Recommend to the Parks and Recreation Department, the Mayor and 28 29 City Council guidelines and procedures governing the operation,
  - (A) Recommend to the Parks and Recreation Department, the Mayor and City Council guidelines and procedures governing the operation, management, and development of the park, including event review and appropriate fee schedules.
  - (B) Review and recommend with respect to the approval or denial of agreements with short term park tenants. Short term park tenants shall be

- approved by the Parks and Recreation Department under guidelines and procedures adopted by City Council resolution.
  - (C) Review and recommend with respect to the approval or denial of agreements with long term park tenants. Long term park tenancies shall not be in effect until approved by the City Council.
  - (D) Review all existing licensure agreements, lease agreements, and similar agreements and make recommendations to the Parks and Recreation Department, Mayor and City Council with respect to the status and continuation of those agreements.
  - (E) Review and recommend to the Parks and Recreation Department, the Mayor and City Council regarding the yearly operating budget and city's general obligation bond program.
- (F) Receive actual timely notice of all proposed planning and development actions within the park, including but not limited to: any permanent changes to the physical layout of the park; any construction within the park, any changes to the Site Development Plan and any application for any such changes. The Commission has the right to participate in, review and have its position given full consideration with respect to any planning and development actions related to the park. The Commission shall have standing in front of all city boards or commissions authorized to consider or review such actions, and in front of the City Council for any appeal or other consideration of such actions.
  - (G) Recommend sponsorships for the park and park events.
  - (H) Work collaboratively with other organizations to market the park.
- **(I)** Such other powers not inconsistent with law that are necessary to fully perform the assigned duties."
- SECTION 2. Section 10-10-7 of the Balloon Fiesta Park Commission Ordinance is amended as follows:
  - "§ 10-10-7 ESTABLISHING THE BALLOON FIESTA PARK STAFF LIAISON.
- (A) The Balloon Fiesta park staff liaison shall be a Parks and Recreation Department employee designated as the liaison between the Commission and various city departments, including but not limited to city departments

- 1 responsible for the capital improvements of the park, the Anderson-Abruzzo 2 Albuquerque International Museum and the landfills in the park. 3 (B) The Balloon Fiesta park liaison shall attend the regular Commission 4 meetings to report on activities and deal with matters within the Commission's 5 authority." 6 SECTION 3. COMPILATION. The amendments set forth in Sections 1 7 and 2 above shall amend, be incorporated in and made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994. 8 SECTION 4. COMPLETION OF TERMS FOR EXISTING MEMBERS. 9 A. The members of the Balloon Fiesta Park Commission seated at the time 10 this amendment becomes effective are permitted to remain seated for the 11 12 timeframes described below, pursuant to the following staggered schedule: 13 1. Members to be replaced after one year. The following members shall be replaced after the expiration of one year from the date of enactment: 14 15 a. The representative from the Board of Directors of the Albuquerque 16 International Balloon Fiesta who has been serving longest: 17 b. The representative from the Wildflower Neighborhood Association: 18 c. The person representing the broader recreation interests of the 19 community and the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Advisory Board; and 20 d. The person who has been serving the longest in the at-large 21 position, filled by persons residing in other areas of the city, in particular, one 22 person from the west side of the city and the other person from the east side 23 of the city. 24 2. Members to be replaced after two years. The following members shall 25 be replaced after the expiration of two years from the date of enactment: 26 a. The representatives from the Board of Directors of the Albuquerque 27 International Balloon Fiesta who was not replaced pursuant to subsection 28 (A)(1)(a) above: 29 b. The representative from the Alameda North Valley Association:

  - c. The person representing local businesses located near the park;
  - d. The person representing the Albuquerque Convention and Visitors Bureau; and

e.	The at-large position, filled by persons residing in other areas of the
city, in pa	rticular, one person from the west side of the city and the other
person fro	om the east side of the city, who was not replaced pursuant to
subsectio	on (A)(1)(d) above.

- B. After the expiration of the timeframes describe in subsection 'A' above, new members will be appointed to fill the newly vacant positions, and those members being replaced may be reappointed only after sitting out for at least one term.
- SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days after publication by title and general summary.
