4 SECTION 2. PROSPECTIVE APPLICATION. The amendment adopted
5 herein applies immediately for all the employees identified in Section 1, above,
6 unless such employees are represented by a labor bargaining unit, in which
7 case this amendment will apply only upon the expiration of the existing
8 agreement, or the expiration of the agreement currently under negotiation.

9 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this ordinance shall amend, be incorporated in
10 and made a part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico,
11 1994.

12 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
13 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
14 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
15 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council
16 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,
17 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
18 provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.


19 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days


