- 5 members appointed by the City Council. The Board shall elect a chair from its
- 6 members.
- 7 B. The term of office for members of the Board shall be for three years
- 8 unless the appointment is to fill a vacancy. Each member may serve a
- 9 maximum of two terms.
- 10 Section 4. DUTIES
- 11 The duties of the Board shall be as follows:
- 12 A. Review the use of the Public Safety Tax revenue for the previous
- 13 fiscal year.
- 14 B. Review the distribution of revenue among the three funded City
- 15 Departments and recommend changes, if necessary, to the percentage of
- 16 revenue distributed, based on community conditions.
- 17 C. Provide recommendations to the Mayor and City Council by January
 - 1 for the proposed use of Public Safety Tax revenues for the upcoming fiscal
- 19 year."

- 20 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, word or
 - phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable
 - by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
 - validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council hereby
 - declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph,
 - sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being
 - declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
 - SECTION 3. COMPILATION. The amendments set forth in Section 1
 - above shall amend, be incorporated in and made part of the Revised
- 29 Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.
- 30 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five
- 31 days after publication by title and general summary.
