ORDINANCE NO. 004-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HALL PUBLIC SAFTY ("HALL") TO OUTFIT THE ONE (1) 2023 CHEVROLET TAHOE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council authorized the purchase of said vehicle pursuant to Ordinance No. 003-23; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that said vehicles be outfitted by Hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Hall** to **outfit** said **vehicle** for the total amount of **Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Forty-Seven Cents (\$18,879.47)**.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Forty-Seven Cents (\$18,879.47)** from **Fund No. 403-1160-00-5-9001-0 to Hall**.

<u>Section 3.</u> That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to outfit the vehicles to ensure efficient operation of the department and avoid any price increase.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
