ORDINANCE NO. 015-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF ENGINEERING FEEs TO **GPD GROUP** FOR ITS SERVICES REGARDING DESIGN COSTS AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR TO THE **LINCOLN WATERLINE** IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this project is known as the Lincoln Waterline Improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends GPD Group perform said services for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to contract with GPD Group for Engineering Design Costs and Construction Administration pursuant to the attached proposal for said project.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed **Seventy-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$78,500.00)**, from **Water Fund 500** to GPD Group for said services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and for the further the City desires to immediately authorize said design to expedite the project.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
