ORDINANCE NO. 020-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **FALLSWAY EQUIPMENT CO. INC.** (“**FALLSWAY**”) TO OUTFIT THE TWO (2) 2024 CHEVROLET TAHOES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford purchased said vehicles to continue efficient operations for the Police Department pursuant to Ordinance No.014-24; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that said vehicles be outfitted by Fallsway, and

WHEREAS, The City was awarded a County CDBG grant of \$150,000.00 for the purchase and outfitting of the vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Fallsway** to outfit said two (2) police vehicles at **Sixteen Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents (\$16,727.59)** each for the total amount of **Thirty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$33,455.18)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Thirty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$33,455.18)** from **CDBG Fund No. 200 to Fallsway**.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to purchase the vehicles to ensure efficient operation of the department and avoid any price increase.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
