ORDINANCE NO. 025-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **CINTAS CORPORATION** FOR THE RENTAL AND CLEANING COSTS FOR FACILITY SERVICE SUPPLIES FOR MULTIPLE CITY BUILDINGS, INCLUDING MATS AND GARMENTS FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT AND WASTE WATER PERSONNEL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends a **3-Year Contract** with **Cintas Corporation** to provide said services, and

WHEREAS, the Cintas Corporation is part of the Omnia Participating Public Agencies (Contract No. 222886)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Cintas Corporation** for the rental and cleaning costs for the facility service supplies for multiple City buildings, including mats and garments for the Service Department and the Waste Water Personnel for the rental agreement cost of **Fifty Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$50,927.96)** annually.

Section 2. the Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay an amount not to exceed **Fifty Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$50,927.96)** from **General Fund 110, Streets Maintenance and Repairs Fund No. 209, Water Fund No. 500, and Waste Water Fund No. 501** to **Cintas Corporation** for said services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the for said service as stated in the rental agreement.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
