ORDINANCE NO. 036-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH INDUSTRIAL APPRAISAL COMPANY FOR PROFESSIONAL APPRAISAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has recommended that the City appraise its assets to obtain values to accurately reflect the City's financial condition, and

WHEREAS, Council concurs with said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract for professional appraisal services with **Industrial Appraisal Company.**

Section 2. Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay an amount of **Thirteen Thousand Seventy-Fine Dollars and Zero Cents (\$13,075.00)** from General **Fund No. 110-** to **Industrial Appraisal Company** for professional appraisal services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare so the City can comply with reporting requirements in a timely manner.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
