ORDINANCE NO. 042-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VALLEY TRUCK CENTERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2024 FORD UTILITY TRUCK FOR THE WATER DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford wishes to purchase a 2024 Ford Utility Truck for the Water Department to enhance service to the public and replace a 2010 Utility Truck, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends the purchase of one (1) 2024 Ford Utility Truck from Valley Truck Centers, pursuant to the State of Ohio Contract No. RS101080.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Valley Truck Center for the purchase of one (1) Ford Utility Truck in the amount of **One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Fifty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$113,058.00)** for the purchase of said vehicle for the Water Department

Section 2. The Finance Director for the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay an amount not to exceed **One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Fifty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$113,058.00)** from **Water Fund No. 500** to **Valley Truck Centers** for the purchase of said vehicle.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to purchase this to replace a 2010 Utility Truck at a reduced price as soon as possible.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
