ORDINANCE NO. 046-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CAMPO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL EXTERIORS (“CAMPO”) TO REPLACE THE ROOF ABOVE THE KITCHEN AT ELLENWOOD RECREATION CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Campo replace the roof above the kitchen at Ellenwood Recreation Center which is in need of repair, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Campo for the replacement of the roof above the kitchen at Ellenwood Recreation Center pursuant to the terms contained in the attached quote incorporated herein.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the necessary sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$17,000.00) from **Capital Improvements Fund No. 403** to Campo for said services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, and to continue efficient services for the residents and avoid any damage to the center.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
