ORDINANCE NO. 081-23

BEING AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF BEDFORD, OHIO DURING THE YEAR **2024** AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is provided by law that an appropriation ordinance may be passed by City Council, and

WHEREAS, the General Code of Ohio and the Charter of the City of Bedford provide for such ordinance and the method of enacting same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That to provide for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Bedford, Ohio, during the year **2024**, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Treasury for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certification and voucher therefore approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve the same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law and ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> All operating transfers of the City of Bedford previously and subsequently authorized by Council in appropriation ordinances this year, shall be transferred in 1/12 increments monthly, unless

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noted herein this section as an exception. The transfers recorded in this ordinance may be transferred up to the appropriated authorized amount, in a single, or by, various transactions at the discretion of the Finance Director.

<u>Section 4.</u> That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Bedford.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
