## ORDINANCE NO. 087-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **THOMPSON HOVAN HEATING AND COOLING** FOR THE BOILER REPLACEMENT IN THE METER BUILDING AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends the replacement of said boiler for the reason that it was originally installed in 1930 and has been rendered inoperable, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends Thompson Hovan Heating and Cooling to replace the boiler in the Meter Building at the WWTP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Thompson Hovan Heating and Cooling** for said services pursuant to the terms of the attached quote.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$19,250.00) from Wastewater Fund No. 501 to Thompson Hovan Heating and Cooling for said services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and to continue efficient operations.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
