ORDINANCE NO. 091-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **BRITE** FOR THE PURCHASE OF TEN (10) GETACH MOBILE DATA TERMINAL (“MDT”) UNITS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford wishes to purchase said units for the Police Department to continue efficient operations and to maintain public safety, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends the City purchase MDT Units from Brite.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Brite** to purchase Ten (10) GeTach MDT Units for the total amount of **Forty-Three Thousand Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$43,061.30)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Forty-Three Thousand Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$43,061.30)** from **Capital Improvements Fund No. 403** pursuant to the terms of the contract to Brite.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the public, and for the further reason that it is necessary to continue efficient operations.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
