ORDINANCE NO. 098-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH W.S. DARLEY & CO. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A GEAR DRYER FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that the City purchase a gear dryer for the Fire Department to assist in the cleaning of life-saving equipment for the department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with W.S. Darley & Co. for the purchase of a gear dryer for the Fire Department for the total purchase amount of **Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and Ninety-Five Cents (\$9,126.95)** of which **One Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Sixteen Cents (\$1,521.16)** will be paid by the City and the remaining amount of **Seven Thousand Six Hundred Five Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$7,605.79)** being paid through a BWC Grant Award and the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign any documents necessary to facilitate the transaction.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the total of **Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and Ninety-Five Cents (\$9,126.95)** from **Grants Fund No. 213** to **W.S. Darley & Co.** for said equipment with the remaining amount being paid by said grant.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that the City of Bedford wants to immediately purchase said equipment to enhance services and assist firefighters.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
