ORDINANCE NO. 10,011-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **CLEAN HARBORS** FOR CHEMICAL REMOVAL AT THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the WWTP Superintendent has obtained quotes **for hazardous chemical removal** at the WWTP pursuant to EPA compliance standards, and

WHEREAS, the Administration and Superintendent recommends **Clean Harbors** to safely remove and dispose of said chemicals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with **Clean Harbors** for **hazardous chemical removal** for the total amount of **Twenty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$29, 316.18)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed **Twenty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$29, 316.18)** from **Fund No. 501-9521-00-5-5900-0** to **Clean Harbors**.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to meet EPA compliance standards.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
