ORDINANCE NO. 10,019-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIRNA CONSTRUCTION, INC. (SIRNA) FOR THE 2022 SIDEWALK REPAIR PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends concrete sidewalk repairs on Columbus Street and Helper Drive, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends Sirna to perform the repairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with **Sirna** for the **2022 Sidewalk Repair Program** pursuant to the terms of the attached estimate.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed **Forty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$48,245.00)** from **Fund No. 403-6402-00-5-8950-0** to **Sirna** pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare to commence work this fall.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
