ORDINANCE NO. 10,020-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH **WALT KUCHARSKI SEPTIC SERVICE, INC.** (**KUCHARSKI**) FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE SLUDGE THICKENER TANK AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the WWTP was in need of emergency repairs to said tank as it was necessary to clean the tank and remove obstructions that impeded operations, and

WHEREAS, the Administration hired Kucharski to do the emergency repairs which was hereby ratified issues at the WWTP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> the Council for the City of Bedford hereby ratifies the hiring of Kucharski for said services pursuant to the terms of the attached quote and hereby finds that an emergency repair was necessary.

<u>Section 2.</u> the Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed **Ten Thousand Six Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents** (\$10,600.00) from **Fund No. 501-9523-00-5-9003-0-0** to **Kucharski** for said services.,

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and to continue efficient operations.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
