## ORDINANCE NO. 10,027-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10,001-22 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH **GPD GROUP** FOR ITS SERVICES REGARDING DESIGN, BIDDING AND PERMITTING, AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE RENOVATION OF THE POOL HOUSE IN THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Bedford pool house is in need of replacement to continue efficient operations, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommended GPD Group perform Design, Bidding and Permitting, and Construction Administration Costs for the project pursuant to Ordinance No. 10,001-22, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance needs to be amended to reallocate payment from the funds stated below

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to contract with GPD Group for Design, Bidding and Permitting, and Construction Administration Costs for said project.

Section 2. The Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay a sum not to exceed Seventy-Seven Thousand Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$77,050.00), of which Fifty-Eight Thousand, Seven-Hundred, Ten Dollars and Seventy-Seven Cents (\$58,710.77) is to come from Fund No. 200-3230-00-5-9000-0 and Eighteen-Thousand, Three-Hundred, Thirty-Nine Dollars and Twenty-Three Cents (\$18,339.23) is to come from fund 217-4008-00-5-9000-0 to GPD Group for said Design, Bidding and Permitting, and Construction Administration Costs pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and for the further the City desires to immediately authorize said design to expedite the project.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
