## ORDINANCE NO. 9939-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PHASE II STORMWATER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CUYAHOGA BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE AUTHORITY AND CONSENT TO PROVIDE PHASE II STORMWATER SERVICES IN YEARS 2022-2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, coordination with the Districts and the necessary technical assistance in implementing soil and water conservation measures by the Districts under said agreement constitutes part of the City's compliance with the Stormwater Management Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Phase II Stormwater Services Agreement with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for the authority and consent to provide Phase II Stormwater Services in the years 2022-2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare relating to the City's Stormwater Management Program.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
