## ORDINANCE NO. 9969-22

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 9959-22 AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING INC.** AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Manager has been authorized and directed by the Council of the City of Bedford to enter said contract pursuant to Ordinance No. 9959-22 for the **Broadway Avenue Waterline Improvements Project**, and

WHEREAS, the Administration desires to reallocate the payment for the contract to reflect fund numbers for different aspects of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Council hereby reaffirms said authorization for the contract with **Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Inc.** for said project in the amount of **\$1,298,791.50** to be paid from the funds as stated below.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed \$1,298,791.50 to Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Inc. for said project pursuant to the terms of the contract with \$816,025.80 being paid from Fund No. 500-9512-00-5-9633-0, \$300,000.00 from Fund No. 403-6170-00-5-9110-0, \$133,863.70 from Fund No. 217-4008-00-5-9003-0, and \$48,902.00 from Fund No. 501-9522-00-5-8008-0.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Revised Code Section 121.22.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the Council to amend said ordinance, to appropriate funds to timely pay for said contract.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
