ORDINANCE NO. 9980-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING CO. INC.** FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE STORM SEWER ON CORKHILL ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the City perform emergency repairs to the thirty-inch storm sewer at a depth of twenty feet, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co. Inc. to perform said repairs located at Corkhill Road due to the complex nature of the repairs and the need for immediate repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co. Inc.** for said services pursuant to the terms of the attached quote.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum not to exceed **Thirty-Six Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents** (\$36,185.00) to **Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co. Inc.** from **Fund No. 209-6211-00-5-9510-0** for said services.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
