RESOLUTION NO. 2605-23

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council in accordance with the provisions of the law has previously adopted a tax budget for the succeeding fiscal year commencing on January 1, 2023 for collection in 2024.

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate of the County Fiscal Officer of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without and what part within the twenty-one-point seven mill tax limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bedford, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification be and the same are hereby accepted and be it further RESOLVED that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said City the rate of each tax necessary to be levied without the twenty-one-point seven mill limitation as follows:

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to certify this approval document at the earliest time.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
