RESOLUTION NO. 2611-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BEDFORD TO PARTICIPATE IN CUYAHOGA COUNTY'S 9-1-1 PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas the City of Bedford is located within the County of Cuyahoga and is therefore part of Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 service network; and

Whereas Cuyahoga County maintains a 9-1-1 Plan in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, Section 128.07; and

Whereas Cuyahoga County has provided a copy of the 9-1-1 Plan to the City of Bedford in accordance with Ohio Revised Code, Section 128.07; and

Whereas the City of Bedford wishes to assist Cuyahoga County in complying with Ohio Revised Code, Section 128.08 by offering this resolution signifying **approval or rejection** of said plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The 9-1-1 Plan of Cuyahoga County, Dated March 6, 2024, is hereby fully approved by the Council of the City of Bedford.

Section 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, and for participation in Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 Plan.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
