A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE INFRASTRUCTURE BANK ("SIB") FOR THE NECESSARY REPAIRS TO THE GREENCROFT ROAD CULVERT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration has determined that the Greencroft Road culvert over Woodcreek is in critical condition, and

WHEREAS, The City of Bedford wants to apply for funding through the State Infrastructure Bank for funding toward the necessary repairs which will exceed \$500,000.00 for the Greencroft Road Culvert; and

WHEREAS, the State Infrastructure Bank is used as a method of funding highway, rail, transit, intermodal, and other transportation facilities and projects through the Ohio Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply through the State Infrastructure Bank for funds necessary to repair the Greencroft Road Culvert and to sign any documents necessary to facilitate the process including acceptance requested by the bank and/or the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Section 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford for the further reason that the City wants to immediately apply for said funds for the repairs.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
