Section 1. That Chapter 2 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words that are in strikethrough font contained in brackets [] and adding those words that are underlined, to read as follows:

DIVISION B: MUNICIPAL MERIT SYSTEM

§ 2.67 MERIT SYSTEM ADOPTED.

A municipal merit system, pursuant to the provisions of M.S. Chapter 44, as it may be amended from time to time, <u>and as supplanted by section 6.03 of the city charter</u>, is hereby adopted by the city for all municipal employees, except: [those employees excluded by the terms of M.S. Chapter 44, as it may be amended from time to time, the Assistant Manager, employees regularly engaged on a scheduled but less than full-time basis and temporary employees, paid on an hourly or weekly basis]

- (a) the City Manager and his or her non-clerical employees;
- (b) the City Attorney and his or her non-clerical employees;
- (c) employees hired to fill temporary or seasonal positions; and
- (d) <u>employees working a limited or variable number of hours that averages less than twenty hours per week over the course of a calendar year.</u>
