

ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - 2

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BLOOMINGTON CITY CODE,
CHAPTER 10, ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL, ARTICLE II – SOLID WASTE AND REFUSE;
AND CHAPTER 11, WATER, WASTEWATER, SOLID WASTE AND UTILITY SERVICES**

The City Council of the City of Bloomington hereby ordains:

Section 1. That Chapter 10 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words that are in ~~strike through~~ font contained in brackets [] and adding those words that are underlined, to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 10
ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL**

ARTICLE II. SOLID WASTE AND REFUSE

SEC. 10.04. DEFINITIONS.

The following word or term, when used in this Article II, shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

CITY-WIDE CURBSIDE CLEANUP PROGRAM. Annual program for pick-up of refuse, brush, appliances, and scrap metal, including neighborhood programs related to solid waste planning, promotion, education and program development. The City-wide Curbside Cleanup Program is available to all RDUs as defined herein, and to those residential units not included in the definition of RDU for which the full association has opted into the City-wide Curbside Cleanup Program.

EXTRA COLLECTION. The collection of residential solid waste, including trash, recyclables, yard waste, organics, bulky wastes, and other additional collection service options collected in addition to or outside of the regular collection day.

* * *

LATE SET OUT COLLECTION. The failure of an RDU to set out trash, recyclables, yard waste, organics cart(s), or bulky wastes, electronic wastes, and other additional collection service options for collection by 7:00 a.m. on collection service day. An RDU that sets out a cart or materials after 7:00 a.m. may request a Late Set Out Collection for the costs established in Section 11.65.01.

Section 2. That Chapter 11 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words that are in ~~strike through~~ font contained in brackets [] and adding those words that are underlined, to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 11
WATER, WASTEWATER, SOLID WASTE AND REFUSE UTILITY SERVICES**

ARTICLE VI. FEES AND RATES FOR UTILITY SERVICES

SEC. 11.65.01. SOLID WASTE AND REFUSE COLLECTION FEES.

(d) Yard waste subscription service (annual cost per household per year, including collection and processing/composting costs):

Full season (any amount)	April 1 through November 30	\$79.50
Partial, first season (unlimited yard waste)	January 1 to July 31	\$79.50
Partial, first season (unlimited yard waste)	August 1 to December 31	\$49.75 (first season)
On-call	April 1 through November 30	\$4.00 per bag
Holiday Tree Collection	[First full two weeks of January] <u>After January 1 each year for two full pick-up cycles commencing on the day after the New Year's holiday or the observed New Year's holiday</u>	\$10.00 per tree
Holiday Tree Collection	Outside of the Holiday Tree Collection timeframe listed above	\$50.00 per tree

<u>Yard Waste</u>	<u>\$10.00 per service</u>
