

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 24****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14.03 OF THE CITY CODE  
CONCERNING THE FEES CHARGED FOR VARIOUS LICENSES AND PERMITS**

The City Council of the City of Bloomington hereby ordains:

Section 1. That Section 14.03 of the Bloomington City Code is hereby amended by adding those words that are underlined, and striking those words shown within brackets, to read as follows:

**§ 14.03 FEES.**

Except as otherwise stated in this code, the fees for the various licenses and permits shall be as hereinafter stated.
