ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 14 AND 15 OF THE CITY CODE FOR WELLS CONSISTENT WITH RECENT AMENDMENTS TO MINNESOTA STATUTES CHAPTER 1031.

The City Council of the City of Bloomington, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. That Chapter 14 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words within brackets and [stricken through] and adding those words that are <u>underlined</u>, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 14: LICENSES AND PERMITS

ARTICLE I: GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 14.03 FEES.

Except as otherwise stated in this code, the fees for the various licenses and permits shall be as

§ 15.159 INCORPORATION OF STATE LAW; WELL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND SEALING; DEFINITIONS.

(c) For the purposes of this Division D, the following terms shall have the described meanings.

WELL, DEWATERING WELL, ENVIRONMENTAL WELL and TEMPORARY [ENVIRONMENTAL WELL]

BORING. Shall have the meanings given in M.S. Chapter 103I, as it may be amended from time to time.

§ 15.160 PERMITS REQUIRED.

Passed and adopted this 15th day of July, 2019.

(a) No person shall construct or reconstruct a dewatering well, environmental well, temporary [environmental well] boring, or water supply well without a permit and inspection at a time designated by the city.

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§ 15.161 REPORTS.

Any person who constructs, reconstructs, or seals an environmental well, temporary [environmental well] boring, dewatering well, or water supply well shall submit to the city within [30]60 days of completion of the work the reports and records required by state law and regulations.
