ORDINANCE NO. 2020-53

AN ORDINANCE TO CLARIFY RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ARE VEHICLES ELIGIBLE FOR LICENSING BY THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, THEREBY AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CITY CODE

The City Council of the City of Bloomington, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. That Chapter 21 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words that are contained in brackets and [stricken through] and adding those words that are <u>underlined</u>, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 21

ARTICLE III: DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

Division A: General Standards

21.301.13 RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

(b) *Definitions.* The following words and terms used in this section shall have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE.

(1) Any self-propelled vehicle and any vehicle propelled, drawn, towed, or carried by a self-propelled vehicle, <u>and eligible to be licensed as a recreational vehicle by the State of Minnesota</u>, which is designed to be used for temporary living quarters while engaged in recreational or vacation activities, containing at least four of the following life support systems, two of which must be subsections (A), (B), or (C) below:

- (A) Cooking with liquid propane gas supply;
- (B) Portable water supply including sink and faucet;
- (C) Separate 110-125 volt electrical power supply;
- (D) Heating or air conditioning;
- (E) Refrigerator, electric or propane; and

(F) Toilet, self-contained or connected to a plumbing system; but not including manufactured homes or house trailers as defined in M.S. § 327.31, as it may be amended from time to time;
