

1 fees. The city council shall adopt a schedule of such permit fees and establish such rules,
2 regulations and restrictions as it determines necessary to implement administration of this
3 section, including delegating to the city manager the authority to issue such permits and
4 prescribe a form of insignia or emblem of exemption to be placed upon an exempted vehicle.
5 Vehicles acquiring exemption pursuant to this section shall, however, be subject to all other
6 provisions of this title.

7 B. Commercial vehicles shall be exempted from the preceding section while loading and
8 unloading materials for a period not exceeding 20 minutes.

9 C. City-owned vehicles or equipment, when parked by a city officer or employee while
10 engaged in the performance of their official duties, shall be exempt from the provisions of the
11 preceding section. The city council may, in its discretion, when it deems public necessity and
12 convenience so requires, exempt without charge federal, state and county-owned vehicles from
13 the provisions of the preceding section.

14 D. The city council may, in its discretion, exempt certain other vehicles from the
15 requirements of this title as to depositing the amount required in parking meters in off-street
16 parking lots where such vehicles are operated by persons attending conventions or other special
17 events within the city. Such vehicles and persons shall be subject to rules and regulations
18 promulgated by the city manager and approved by the city council.

19 **Section 4.** That section 10.25.050 of the Chico Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

20 **10.25.050 Collection of parking meter revenue.**

21 The administrative services director or finance director shall collect, or cause to be collected, all
22 funds deposited in parking meters at least once each week. An accurate record of all amounts so
23 collected shall be maintained.

24 **Section 5.** That section 10.25.060 of the Chico Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

25 **10.25.060 Purpose and use of parking meter revenue.**

26 The specific amounts required to be deposited in parking meters, together with the permit fees
27 specified, all as provided for in this chapter, is hereby levied and assessed to provide for the
28 proper regulation and control of traffic upon the streets and within the parking facilities of the

1 city; for the cost of supervision and regulation of parking meters within the parking meter zones
2 hereby authorized; to cover the costs of purchasing, acquiring, installing, operating, regulating
3 and controlling the parking meters herein described; to pay for the operations and maintenance of
4 areas located between the parking space and customers' point of destination which could include
5 reconstruction, maintenance and cleaning of the streets, curbs and sidewalks; to pay and secure
6 the payment of the principal and interest on bonds issued by the city pursuant to Chapter 3.6 and
7 to operate and maintain the public off-street parking facilities provided by the city pursuant to
8 such chapter. In addition, when authorized by the city council, such funds may also be used to
9 support any alternative transportation programs funded by the city.

10 **Section 6.** That section 10.25.070 of the Chico Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

11 **10.25.070 Installation, servicing, maintenance and repair of parking meters.**

12 The public works director shall be responsible for the installation, servicing, maintenance and
13 repair of all parking meters.

14 **Section 7.** That section 10.25.080 of the Chico Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

15 **10.25.080 Parking limits in metered parking spaces.**

16 No person, except as otherwise provided in this title, shall permit any vehicle to remain parked in
17 any parking meter space during any time when the parking meter adjacent to the space indicates
18 that no portion remains of the period for which the last amounts had been deposited, or beyond
19 the time limit for parking in such space as otherwise provided in this title.

20 **Section 8.** That section 10.25.090 of the Chico Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

21 **10.25.090 Use of slugs - Prohibited.**

22 No person shall deposit or attempt to deposit in any parking meter any slugs or other counterfeit
23 payment in place of the amounts required to operate the parking meter.




