



1 director will coordinate and work in conjunction to achieve the overall goals and objectives of  
2 the department. In the event that one of the directors is absent or a vacancy exists, the remaining  
3 director shall assume all responsibilities for all divisions within the public works department.

4 B. The public works directors shall be responsible for the direction and the control of all  
5 functions and duties assigned to the department. The directors shall:

6 1. Manage the functions and duties assigned to the department by section 2.30.020 and any  
7 other provisions of this code;

8 2. Manage and recommend changes to the capital improvement program to reflect changes in  
9 project costs and council priorities and coordinate implementation of the program with  
10 implementation of the city's general plan.

11 3. Attend all meetings of the Bidwell Park and Playground Commission or delegate that duty  
12 to department personnel with the appropriate level of training and experience.

13 4. As needed, attend meetings of the planning commission, or delegate those duties to  
14 department personnel with the appropriate level of training and experience.

15 5. As needed, attend meetings of the council;

16 6. Recommend revisions to the rules, regulations, or operations of the city concerning the  
17 department's functions and duties; and

18 7. Perform such other duties, not inconsistent with the city charter or this code, as the city  
19 manager may direct.

20 **Section 4.** The City Council finds and determines that the enactment of this Ordinance is not  
21 a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Cal Pub. Resource Code §§  
22 21000 et seq.) in that the activities described in the Ordinance are a continuing administrative  
23 activity of the City involving general policy and procedure making and organizational or  
24 administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical  
25 changes in the environment. (State CEQA Guidelines, Cal. Code of Regs., Title 14, § 15378.)  
26 Therefore, no environmental assessment is required or necessary.

27 **Section 5.** If any part of this Ordinance, or its application to any individual, entity, or  
28 circumstance, is held to be invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance, including the application or  
provision to other persons or circumstances, shall be not be affected and shall continue in full  
force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

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**Section 6.** The City Clerk shall attest to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause same to be posted as required by law, and this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) calendar days after its adoption.


