

ORDINANCE NO. <u>2605</u>

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICO AMENDING CHAPTERS 12.18 AND 12R.04 OF THE CHICO MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT CITY PLAZA (City of Chico)

WHEREAS, the City of Chico ("City") is a Charter City, incorporated under the laws of the State of California, and has the power to make and enforce within its jurisdictional limits laws and regulations in respect to municipal affairs subject only to such restriction and limitations as may be provided in the Constitution of the State of California or provision of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, Sections 12.18.065 and 12R.04.056 authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages at the City Plaza during a public event as authorized by and pursuant to the valid issuance of a City of Chico Park Use Permit and a license issued by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control; and

WHEREAS, the Chico City Council desires to amend Chapters 12.18 and 12R.04 to permit, in addition to the sale, the service and provision of alcoholic beverages during authorized events at City Plaza with the appropriate approvals required under the Chico Municipal Code.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chico:

SECTION 1. Section 12.18.065 of Chapter 12.18 of Title 12 – "Parks" – is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.18.065 Alcoholic beverages - City Plaza.

- A. Notwithstanding sections 12.18.030 and 12.18.050 above, no person shall sell, serve, or provide alcoholic beverages at the City Plaza during an event except as authorized by and pursuant to the valid issuance of a City of Chico Park Use Permit and an appropriate license issued by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, and any person over the age of 21 years may possess or consume alcoholic beverages at the City Plaza during such event, as permitted by this section 12.18.065.
- B. Application for a City of Chico Park Use Permit as provided in CMC 12R.10 authorizing the sale, service, provision, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages in City Plaza

shall be filed with the director at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the date the public event is to take place. Application shall be in the form prescribed by the director and shall contain all information required by the director. Permits authorized by this subsection B- must be approved by the director or designee, the Chief of Police or designee, and the City Manager or designee.

C. Following the filing of an application for a permit under this section, the director shall issue a permit granting an exemption from sections 12.18.030, 12.18.050, 12R.04.030, and 12R.04.050 if the director finds that the public event complies with all requirements otherwise set forth in this chapter as well as any reasonable requirements and conditions imposed by the director within or in addition to the permit application, including inclusion of a site plan, security plan, and proof of appropriate insurance.

SECTION 2. Section 12R.04.056 entitled "Alcoholic beverages – City Plaza" of Chapter 12R.04 of Title 12R is hereby amended to read as follows:

12R.04.056 Alcoholic beverages - City Plaza.

- A. Notwithstanding sections 12R.04.030 and 12R.04.050 above, no person shall sell, serve, or provide alcoholic beverages at the City Plaza during an event except as authorized by and pursuant to the valid issuance of a City of Chico Park Use Permit and an appropriate license issued by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, and any person over the age of 21 years may possess or consume alcoholic beverages at the City Plaza during such event, as permitted by this section 12R.04.056.
- B. Application for a City of Chico Park Use Permit authorizing the sale, service, provision, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages in City Plaza shall be filed with the director at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the date the event is to take place. Application shall be in the form prescribed by the director and shall contain all information required by the director. Permits authorized by this subsection B. must be approved by the director or designee, the Chief of Police or designee, and the City Manager or designee.
- C. Following the filing of an application for a permit under this section, the director shall issue a permit granting an exemption from sections 12.18.030, 12.18.050,

12R.04.030, and 12R.04.050 if the director finds that the event complies with all requirements otherwise set forth in this chapter as well as any reasonable requirements and conditions imposed by the director within or in addition to the permit application, including inclusion of a site plan, security plan, and proof of appropriate insurance.

SECTION 3. CEQA. The City Council, on the basis of the whole record and exercising independent judgment, finds that this Ordinance is exempt from the provision of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment. The Chico Municipal Code currently permits the sale of alcoholic beverages at City Plaza during approved events and this Ordinance merely authorizes the service and provision of alcoholic beverages during approved events where alcoholic beverages are not being sold.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, line, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, either facially or as applied, by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council of the City of Chico hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each and every individual section, subsection, line, sentence, clause, phrase, or word without regard to any such decision.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. The Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its final adoption by the City Council.

SECTION 6. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published or posted in the manner required by law.
