ORDINANCE 31-22

AMENDMENT TO CITY OF CLAREMONT CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLE SIX, LICENSING AND
REGISTRATION, CHAPTER TWO, STREET AND SIDEWALK USE AND REGULATION (6-2-21)

WHEREAS, The City of Claremont strives to ensure the safety of the motoring and bicycling public through thoughtful and careful traffic planning and selective enforcement of traffic laws, as well as to maintain the good appearance and maintenance of city streets, sidewalks and stormwater systems.

WHEREAS, The City of Claremont has received numerous complaints concerning soil, grass clippings, or other vegetative clippings being deposited either intentionally or unintentionally from private property upon the streets and sidewalks within the City Limits of Claremont, NC.

WHEREAS, After review and public hearing the City Council of the City of Claremont has determined that the public safety and welfare would be served by the addition of soil, grass clippings, or other vegetative clippings to the list of items prohibited from being deposited upon the city streets and sidewalks within the city limits of the City of Claremont.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY CITY COUNCIL OF CLAREMONT, NORTH CAROLINA, THAT:

Claremont City Ordinance 6-2-21 is amended to add the following:


Sec. 6-2-21 Littering prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit upon any street or sidewalk, or upon any private property, except with written permission of the owner or occupant of the private property, any trash, refuse, garbage, building material, cans, bottles, broken glass, paper, *soil, grass clippings or other type of vegetative trimmings*, or any type of litter. {Ord. of 7/13/71, revised}
