ORDINANCE 36-22**

NC STATE SCIF GRANT PROJECT FUND (FUND 805)  
ORDINANCE TO CREATE A GRANT PROJECT FUND

**BE IT ORDAINED** by City Council of Claremont, North Carolina, that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following Grant Project Fund Ordinance is hereby adopted.

**Section 1** – This ordinance creates a grant revenue project fund to utilize \$250,000 received by the City of Claremont through direct appropriation in the current (FY 2021-23) North Carolina State Budget. This \$250,000 will be applied to work in the Wastewater Treatment Improvements Project (Fund, 801) for use in contracted services (construction) and administration (contract administration/contract observation).

**Section 2** – This ordinance shall remain in effect for the duration of the project; subject to periodic review by the City Council.

**Section 3** – The City Manager is hereby directed to act on behalf of the City Council in all matters associated with the project within the terms of all contracts, agreements and legal requirements binding on the project and within limits of the funds appropriated herein.

**Section 4** – The following revenues are available for this project:

State Direct Appropriation Grant (SCIF)	<u>\$250,000</u>
Total Revenues	<u>\$250,000</u>

**Section 5** – The following amounts are appropriated for the project:

Engineering and Professional Services	\$50,000
Contracted Services	<u>\$200,000</u>
Total Appropriations	<u>\$250,000</u>

**Section 6** – The City Manager is directed to report annually on the financial status of this project and keep the City Council informed of any unusual occurrences associated with the project.

**Section 7** – The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Grant Fund sufficient specific detailed accounting records to provide the accounting to City Council required by the program procedures, loan agreement and state regulations.

**Section 8** – The Finance Officer is directed to report quarterly on the financial status of each grant element in Section 4 and on the total revenues received or claimed.

**Section 9** – Copies of this project ordinance shall be made available to the Budget Officer and the Finance Officer for direction in carrying out this project.
