

**CITY OF CLAREMONT NORTH CAROLINA ORDINANCE 46-22
AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
TITLE 5, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 89**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Claremont places a great emphasis on the maintenance of the health and welfare of our residents within the City of Claremont, and as such has provided for the creation and operation of a well-maintained water distribution and wastewater collection system.

WHEREAS, the City of Claremont proposes to amend the Code of Ordinances regulating the structure and operation of the wastewater collections system to ensure the most professional and efficient service possible to the City of Claremont.

WHEREAS, notification of the public hearing was duly published.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAREMONT, THAT TITLE 5, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 89 OF THE CLAREMONT CITY ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED BY CHANGING THE FOLLOWING:

Sec. 5-1-89 Deposits required.

(a) At the time of request for water or sewer service, ~~each residential customer not owning property~~ for which the service is to be provided shall make a deposit in accordance with the current city fee schedule.

(b) The deposit shall be retained by the city during such time as service is continued ~~and may be applied to payment of future charges; provided, however, that such application to payment shall have no effect upon the operation of the provisions of this chapter relating to nonpayment.~~ Any funds remaining upon termination of service to a customer shall be returned to him.

(c) The deposit required by this section shall be in addition to all other charges, fees, and assessments referred to in this chapter.
