**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON

ORDINANCE NO. 500

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Preamble. WHEREAS, in order to provide for and promote public health, safety and welfare, to protect the wellbeing of the public and provide for the efficient and reliable installation of construction Township owned improvements serving residents and other members of the public within the Charter Township of Clinton promoting and protecting property and the preservation of the quiet enjoyment of property, the following ordinance is presented for adoption.

Section 2. The Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Clinton, Chapter 209.07(B) is hereby revised and amended adding as Section 10 to read as follows:

(10) Fee waiver construction contractor engaged by the Township. At the direction of the Township building director all or part of building department fees may be waived for work on Township owned projects by contractors engaged by the Township paid from Township funds. The building director shall exercise reasonable discretion considering the nature and complexity of the work involved and inspections. All waivers shall be reported to the supervisor.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

Section 4. Severability. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of remaining portions of the ordinance, it being the intent of the Township that this ordinance shall be fully severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. The ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication.


