

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-12**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, NEBRASKA AMENDING COLUMBUS CITY CODE (ORDINANCE NO. 24-01) SECTION 71.999 OF CHAPTER 71 OF TITLE VII, TO AMEND THE CODE REFERENCE TO REFERENCE THE CORRECT ALCOHOLIC TESTING CODE SECTION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

WHEREAS, City Code Section 71.999(B) references City Code Section 71.009 and instead should reference City Code Section 71.008 and this ordinance shall correct this.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 71.999 of Chapter 71 of Title VII of the Columbus City Code shall be amended and revised to read as follows:

**§ 71.999 PENALTY.**

(A) Any person violating any provision of this chapter for which no specific penalty is prescribed shall be subject to § 10.99 of this code of ordinances.

(B) Any person who refuses to submit to the test or tests required pursuant to § 71.008 of this code shall not have the tests taken but shall be found guilty of a traffic infraction and upon conviction shall have that person's operator's license impounded by the court for 90 days for refusal to submit to the tests required pursuant to this section.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall repeal all Ordinances or portions thereof and conflict herewith.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval of publication according to law. Publication shall be in pamphlet form as authorized by Nebraska Revised Statutes § 16-405 with distribution to be made by making copies available to the public upon request at the City office.
