## *Ordinance*

**Ordinance No. 1617**

**Council Bill No. 21-08**

An ordinance amending Ordinance Number 1144, as amended to provide for the payment of pension benefits after twelve (12) years, or more of service.

BE IT ORDANINED by the Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1: Section 6 (A) (C) and Section 6 (A) (D) are hereby amended to read as follows:

(6) (A) (C). A member who shall have served for twelve (12) years, or more, and shall have attained the age of sixty (60) years and whose office or employment shall be terminated with or without his or her voluntary action before the expiration of twenty (20) years of service, he/she shall, in such event, during the remainder of his or her life, be entitled to receive such portion of the annual pension benefit as the period of his or her service up to date of termination bears to the full twenty (20) year period of service.


(6) (A) (D). A member who shall have served for twelve (12) years, or more, and shall not have attained the age of sixty (60) years, and whose office or employment shall be terminated with or without his or her voluntary action before the expiration of twenty (20) years of service, he/she shall, in such event, during the remainder of his or her life, after attaining the age of sixty (60) years, be entitled to receive such portion of the annual pension benefit as the period of his or her service up to the date of termination bears to the full twenty (20) year period of service.

If a member has served for twelve (12) years, or more of service, but less than twenty (20) years of service, and his or her employment is terminated for any reason, then and in that event, he or she will have the option of having the total amount of the contributions paid into the pension fund by such employee refunded to him or her in full, without interest, or receiving the portion of the annual pension set forth above.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage.
