Ordinance No. 1619

Council Bill No. 21-10

An ordinance amending Ordinances Number 768 and 1074, as amended to provide for the Police contribution rates to the Police pension and to provide for payment of pension benefits after twelve (12) years, or more, of service.

BE IT ORDANINED by the Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same that Ordinances No. 768 and 1074 shall be amended as follows

Section 1: Ordinances No. 768 and 1074 are amended, in part, to include the following provisions:

- A. A member who shall have served for twelve (12) years, or more, and shall have attained the age of sixty (60) years and whose office or employment shall be terminated with or without his or her voluntary action before the expiration of twenty (20) years of service, he/she shall, in such event, during the remainder of his or her life, be entitled to receive such portion of the annual pension benefit as the period of his or her service up to the date of termination bears to the full twenty (20) year period of service.
- B. A member who shall have served for twelve (12) years, or more, and shall not have attained the age of sixty (60) years, and whose office or employment shall be terminated with or without his or her voluntary action before the expiration of twenty (20) years of service, he/she shall, in such event, during the remainder of his or her life, after attaining the age of sixty (60) years, be entitled to receive such portion of the annual pension benefit as the period of his or her service up to date of termination bears to the full twenty (20) year period of service.

If a member has served for twelve (12) years, or more of service, but less than twenty (20) years of service, and his or her employment is terminated for any reason, then and in that event, he or she shall have the option of having the total amount of the contributions paid into the pension fund by such employee refunded to him or her in full, without interest, or receiving the portion of the annual pension set forth above.

Section 2: Ordinances No. 768 and 1074 are hereby amended in part, to provide the following provision for police office's contribution to the pension, as follows:


The fund shall be maintained by an equal and proportionate monthly charge against each member of the police force as follows: three (3) percent (3%) and an additional one (1) percent (1%) of each officer's pay effective January 01, 2022; three and one-half (3 1/2 %) percent and an additional one (1) percent (1%) of each officer's pay effective January 01, 2023; and four (4) percent (4%) and an

additional one (1%) percent of each officer's pay effective January 01, 2024. The City of Corry shall make service increment payments of \$200.00 per month, as permitted by the Third Class City Code.


Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
