**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CORRY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE FACE PAYMENT DATE FOR 2020 REAL
ESTATE TAXES**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Corry desires to extend the due date for payment of the face amount of 2020 real estate taxes in recognition of the current state of emergency resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the associated economic impact on the Municipality's residents and taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, Act 15 of 2020, which was signed by the Governor on April 20, 2020, and became effective immediately, amended Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes by adding a new Chapter 57 ("COVID-19 Disaster Emergency") including Subchapter B ("Property Tax Relief"), which authorizes the Council of the City of Corry to provide for property tax relief by extending deadlines for payment of 2020 real estate taxes.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Corry does hereby

RESOLVE, as follows:

1. The deadlines and procedures regarding the collection of taxes imposed on the assessed value of real property for the 2020 tax year that would otherwise be due by December 31, 2020 (the "Tax"), are amended as follows: Fees and penalties associated with the late payment of the Tax shall be waived if the Tax is paid in full by December 31, 2020.
2. This Resolution shall apply to 2020 real estate taxes only and shall not affect the payment deadlines or otherwise impact the levy and/or collection of any other taxes or for past or future real estate taxes assessed by the Municipality.
3. The City Manager or his designee is hereby directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the City Treasurer on or before June 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Corry, this 18th day of May, 2020.
