A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORRY, AMENDING AND REVISING APPENDIX A OF ORDINANCE 1570 BILL 17-01 THE FIRE RESPONSE FEE SCHEDULE.

Appendix A to the Corry Ordinance 1570: Bill 17-01

Fire Response fees: used on reported structure fires, where fire is not active, minor, overheating problem or issue is relatively minor.

Minor fire fee – upon arrival and investigation finds issue has subsided or was identified in a short time frame or work performed was minimal - \$350.00

Non Active Fire – department responded and found no active incident - \$150.00

Billing List

Used when active incident is found upon arrival, to be determined by Officer In charge of Incident.

Such as but not limited to: Active fire, fires extinguished by fire personnel, rescue/recovery operations, salvage work, searches, hazmat incident, utility control and monitoring, medical evaluation, investigation, incident control and monitoring.
