Enacting Smoke Free Properties and Events

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Clean Indoor Air Act, Act 27 of 2008, was signed into law on June 13, 2008. The legislation prohibits smoking in a public place or a workplace. An Act regulating smoking in this Commonwealth; imposing powers and duties on the Department of Health and local boards of health; providing penalties; preempting local action; and making a related repeal.


WHEREAS, smoking products, once consumed in public spaces, are often discarded on the ground requiring additional maintenance expenses, diminish the beauty of the recreational facilities and pose a risk to children, pets, and wildlife due to ingestion; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Corry to protect and promote public health, safety, and welfare by providing smoke-and tobacco-free environments within designated parks, City owned or leased property, and City sponsored events; and


NOW, Therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Corry that all City owned, leased properties as well as City sponsored events shall remain smoke free. Additionally in order to ensure public knowledge of this act all properties shall be posted with signage which shall indicate "No Smoking" including each entrance to the property and each structure on the property.
