A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CORRY APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF DELEGATES TO REPRESENT THE CITY OF CORRY ON THE ERIE COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Act 32 ss 505(b) requires the governing bodies of school districts, townships, boroughs and cities that impose an earned income tax to appoint one voting delegate and one or more alternate delegates to their Tax Collection Committee (TCC) representatives, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this resolution is to appoint the required delegates, and

WHEREAS, The appointed individuals have consented to this appointment.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Corry that the following individuals are re-appointed as TCC delegates for the City of Corry:



AND RESOLVED, that if the primary voting delegate cannot present for a TCC meeting, the first alternate voting delegate shall be the representative at the TCC meeting. If both the primary voting delegate and the first alternate voting delegate cannot be present for a TCC meeting, the second alternate voting delegate shall be the representative at the TCC meeting.

AND FURTHER RESOLVED, these appointments are effective immediately and shall continue until successors are appointed. Delegates shall be appointed each year in November or December or as soon as thereafter possible. All delegates shall serve at the pleasure of this governing body and may be removed at any time.
