

ORDINANCE 342

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELKINS,
WEST VIRGINIA, TO AMEND AND REVISE CHAPTER 35: ELECTIONS
§35.06, CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Elkins, West Virginia previously adopted Ordinance 310 on its final reading on January 19, 2023, said ordinance amended and revised Chapter 35: Elections; and

WHEREAS, the City will hold an election on June 10, 2025, and the Common Council finds and determines that it would be in the best interest of the City and its citizens to amend and revise Chapter 35: Elections, §35.06, Candidate Filing Period.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Elkins, West Virginia that the Elkins City Code, Chapter 35, Elections, §35.06 be amended and shall read as follows:

§35.06 Candidate Filing Period

The candidate filing period shall commence on the second Monday in the February preceding the date of the regular city election. The candidate filing period shall continue until midnight of the third Friday thereafter following the day of its commencement. In the event of a special election, the candidate filing period shall open on a Monday and close on the third Friday thereafter, provided that the closing date must be no later than 90 days preceding the date of the election.

The changes and amendments to Chapter 35: Elections are only to the section referred to herein and all other section of said chapter shall remain in full force and effect.


If any portion of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof and Common Council determines that it would have adopted this Ordinance without the invalid provision.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
