

THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE

ORDINANCE NO. 09-2024

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX, AT THE SAME RATE OF THREE (3.00) MILLS IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, AS PROVIDED FOR IN OHIO REVISED CODE 5705.19(G), AND REQUESTING THE OTTAWA COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE THE AMOUNT OF TAX GENERATED BY THE PROPOSED TAX LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE (3.00) MILLS, A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Elmore, Ohio met in open session on the 8th day of April; and

WHEREAS the amount of taxes which may be raised within the Ten (10) mill levy limit will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of revenue for the necessary requirements for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the Village of Elmore; and

WHEREAS there is an existing tax levy of Three (3.00) Mills due to expire in Tax Year 2024, for the purpose of providing funding for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the Village of Elmore, as provided by ORC 5705.19(G); and

WHEREAS there is a necessity to levy a renewal of the existing tax levy of Three (3.00) Mills due to expire in 2024, for the purpose of funding for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the Village of Elmore, as provided by ORC 5705.19(G); and

WHEREAS ORC 5705.03 requires that the taxing authority shall certify to the county auditor an ordinance requesting the auditor certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the subdivision, and the number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue, or the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, as the taxing authority, to certify to the Auditor, this Ordinance requesting the Auditor certify to the Council, the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a levy of renewal of an existing tax due to expire in tax year 2024, at the same rate of Three (3.00) mills in excess of the Ten (10) Mill limitation, based on the following statements in compliance with ORC 5705.03:

Section 1. The renewal levy is for the purpose of providing funding for payment of the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the Village of Elmore, as provided in ORC 5705.19(G); and

Section 2. The proposed levy is the renewal of an existing tax, at the same rate of three (3.00) mills. The existing levy is due to expire in 2024; and

Section 3. The Ohio Revised Code Section authorizing submission of the question of the tax to all residents in the Village of Elmore in Ottawa and Sandusky counties, State of Ohio, is ORC 5705.19(G); and

Section 4. The renewal levy is for a five (5) year period commencing in tax year 2025, and first due in calendar year 2026, being the tax duplicate year 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029; and

Section 5. The renewal tax is to be levied on the entire territory of the Village in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

Section 6. The date of the election at which the questions of the tax shall appear on the ballot is November 5, 2024; and

Section 7. The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the Village of Elmore in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

Section 8. The tax year in which the tax shall be levied is 2025 and the calendar year in which the tax shall first be collected is 2026, and

Section 9. Ottawa and Sandusky Counties are the only counties upon which the Village of Elmore has territory.

Section 10. The Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby directed to immediately certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Ottawa County Auditor.

Section 11. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council; and all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in compliance with Ohio law, including ORC 121.22.

Section 12. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Elmore to provide for uninterrupted funding needed for the construction and maintenance of Village streets and alleys and shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
