

## ORDINANCE NO. 10-2026

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN VILLAGE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY AS PUBLIC PARKS, NAMING SAID PARKS “PEACE POINT PARK” AND “REED’S HILL PARK,” AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE PUBLIC PARK PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OHIO.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Elmore owns certain real property within the Village suitable for public park and recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to designate and set apart two Village-owned parcels or areas as public parks pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 755.12; and

WHEREAS, Council further desires to officially name said public parks as **Peace Point Park** and **Reed’s Hill Park**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, Ottawa County, Ohio:

### **SECTION 1. Designation of Peace Point Park.**

The Village-owned triangular area located at the point where Clinton Street ends at Rice Street, bounded generally by Clinton Street and Rice Street, is hereby designated and set apart as a public park of the Village of Elmore and shall be officially known as **Peace Point Park**.

### **SECTION 2. Designation of Reed’s Hill Park.**

The Village-owned property located north of Peace Point Park, lying on the north side of Rice Street and bounded generally on the south by Rice Street and on the north by the Portage River, is hereby designated and set apart as a public park of the Village of Elmore and shall be officially known as **Reed’s Hill Park**.

### **SECTION 3. Public Park Use.**

The properties designated in Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance shall be held, maintained, and used for public park, recreation, open space, and related municipal purposes, subject to such rules, regulations, improvements, maintenance, and management as may be authorized by Council from time to time.
