AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PETITION
FOR ANNEXATION GRANTED
BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
IN ITS RESOLUTION NO. 20-43
AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a petition to annex 0.597 acres of the Jacob and Katherine Huss property was granted by the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners in its resolution No. 20-43, and

Whereas, more than sixty days but less than one hundred twenty days have expired since the delivery of documents required by section 709.022 (C) O.R.C., and

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Elmore desires to accept the Petition for Annexation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE THAT:

Section 1. The annexation described herein is accepted.

Section 2. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the area annexed to immediately provide Village services therein including police protection, and as such, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.


