

VILLAGE OF ELMORE

ORDINANCE NO. 12-2024

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL TAX, AT THE RATE OF THREE (3.00) MILLS IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, AS PROVIDED FOR IN OHIO REVISED CODE 5705.19(A), AND REQUESTING THE OTTAWA COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO THE VILLAGE THE AMOUNT OF TAX GENERATED BY THE PROPOSED TAX LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE (3.00) MILLS, A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Elmore, Ohio met in open session on the 22nd day of April; and

WHEREAS the amount of taxes which may be raised within the Ten (10) mill levy limit will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of revenue for the current expenses of the Village; and

WHEREAS there is a necessity to levy an additional tax of Three (3.00) Mills for the purpose of funding the current expenses of the Village, as provided for in **ORC 5705.19(A)**.

WHEREAS ORC 5705.03 requires that the taxing authority shall certify to the county auditor an ordinance requesting the auditor certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the subdivision, and the number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue, or the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, as Taxing authority, to certify to the Ottawa County Auditor, this ordinance requesting the Auditor certify to the Village, the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a levy of an additional tax, at the rate of Three (3.00) Mills in excess of the Ten (10) Mill limitation, based on the following in compliance with ORC 5705.03:

Section 1. The additional tax levy is for the purpose of providing funding for payment of the current expenses of the Village, provided in ORC 5705.19(A); and

Section 2. The proposed levy is an additional tax, at the rate of Three (3.00) Mills; and

Section 3. The Ohio Revised Code Section authorizing submission of the question of the tax to all residents in the Village of Elmore located in both Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, State of Ohio, is ORC 5705.19(A); and

Section 4. The additional levy is for a five (5) year period commencing in tax year 2025, and first due in calendar year 2026, being the tax duplicate year 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029; and

Section 5. The additional tax is to be levied on the entire territory of the Village of Elmore located in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

Section 6. The date of the election at which the questions of the tax shall appear on the ballot is November 5, 2024; and

Section 7. The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the Village of Elmore, in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

Section 8. The tax year in which the tax shall be levied is 2025 and the calendar year in which the tax shall first be collected is 2026; and

Section 9. Ottawa and Sandusky Counties are the only counties upon which the Village of Elmore has territory; and

Section 10. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to immediately certify a copy of the Ordinance to the Ottawa County Auditor; and

Section 11. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council; and all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in compliance with Ohio law, including ORC 121.22

Section 12. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Elmore to provide for uninterrupted services and shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


