## ORDINANCE NO. <u>17-21</u>

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 10-20 TO PROVIDE NEW POSITIONS AND TO CHANGE THE UTILITY CLERK'S PAY RANGE AND TO ADD A WORKING FOREMAN POSITION AND TO SET THE PAY RANGE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance NO. 10-20 provides for a superintendent and acting superintendent and said positions are now known as working foremen instead of superintendent and acting village administrator instead of acting superintendent, and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable to increase the pay range for the utility clerk position to \$9.24 - \$19.25 per hour from \$9.24 - \$17.75;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** The positions of superintendent and acting superintendent in the Department of Public Works are eliminated.

**SECTION 2.** The positions of Working Foreman and Acting Village Administrator are created in the Department of Public Works and shall be compensated as follows:

Working Foreman \$16.82 - \$29.22 per hour paid bi-weekly

Acting Village Administrator (40- hour week) \$50 per week, paid bi-weekly

**SECTION 3.** The position of Utility Clerk shall be compensated as follows:

Utility Clerk \$9.24 - \$19.25 per hour, paid bi-weekly.

Maximum 35 hours.

**SECTION 4.** All remaining provisions of Ordinance NO. 10-20 not inconsistent with the foregoing shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were at meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Elmore and the State of Ohio.
